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
In pursuance to advertisement vide notification no 1 of 2015 dated 01-04 2015 and subsequent evaluation process of eligible candidates conducted through proficiency/written test and interview of shortlisted candidates, the following candidates have been provisionally selected against the project-mode positions as indicated against each and are directed to report to the Principal Investigator/Coordinator, Climate Change Centre under NMSHE Project on or before 01-08-2015. Subsequently, the Principal Investigator shall assign further duties to them as per project requirements. In case the candidate featuring in the select list fails to join by or before 01-08-2015 the next candidate in the waiting list shall be given the opportunity to join for the corresponding position latest by 05-08-2015.

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The appointment shall be purely on contractual basis for a period of one year which would be extended depending upon performance assessment, functional needs of the project, and availability of project funds.
2. The job requires extensive travelling and working under demanding field conditions in high altitude regions.
3. The contractual appointment shall be terminable on either side by prior notice of one month or on payment of one month's salary by the appointing authority.

4. The contractual appointment shall submit himself/herself to the orders of the Government/Department and the Principal Investigator and authorities under whom he/she may be placed from time to time.
5. The Department will pay contractual appointee a consolidated salary as per the notification as long as he/she remain in the service and performs the duties.
6. The contractual appointee shall be entitled to casual leave of 15 days in one year or as per government instructions issued from time to time.
7. The project-mode appointee shall not confer any right to regularization.
8. The appointee shall not claim any TA/DA for field surveys. However, he/she shall be provided free transport/boarding and lodging facility during such surveys. However, in case Government guest house/Govt. accommodation is not made available to the appointees during such tours, then a lump sum amount of Rs.350/= per day shall be paid to them for making their own arrangements.
9. The selectee may be required to travel outside the State for attending project related trainings, workshops etc. For this, he or she shall be paid shared taxi fare and AC 3 tier train fare plus lump sum amount of Rs.700/= as lodging, boarding and local transportation charges per day during project related tours outside State. However, in case, these facilities are provided by the sponsoring agency, then same shall not be reimbursed.
10. If the contractual appointee at any time willfully neglects or refuses to perform his/her duties, the appointing authority shall immediately terminate his/her contractual appointment without any notice and he/she shall not be entitled to any salary for such period.
11. The selectee shall have to work at the office complex at Bemina, Srinagar and Jammu as per requirement. However, he or she may be required to travel throughout the State for conducting field surveys.
12. In case, any candidate succeeded in getting selected by supplying false/concocted information or any unfair means, his appointment shall be liable to be cancelled by the appointing authority at any time and all dues paid to him would be recovered.
13. The appointee will have to work with the department for minimum one-year from the date of his/her joining the duty and to affirm this the appointee has to execute/sign a notarized affidavit/bond with the appointing authority mentioning the above terms and conditions (with the exception, if candidate gets a permanent government position/job).
